1. Responsibilities:

a. Management will:

1. Provide and maintain a safe work environment, safe equipment, and proper materials.
2. Identify, assess, and manage risks and hazards.
3. Comply with all applicable legislative requirements and any other applicable international standards.
4. Provide proper training and supervision to workers.
5. Promote a culture of safety and health ensuring consultation and participation of all workers in the H&S Management System
6. Contribute towards continual improvement of the H&S Management System

b. Employees and sub-contractors:

1. To follow safety instructions and procedures.
2. Report unsafe conditions or incidents.
3. Use personal protective equipment (PPE) as required.

2. Training and Competency:

Ensure that both employees and contractors receive the required training and possess the necessary skills to perform their tasks safely.

3. Incident and Hazard Reporting:

Incidents, near misses, and hazards to be reported immediately to site management and the Health, Safety and Environmental Department.

4. Emergency Procedures:


Emergency response procedures will be clearly outlined and communicated to all staff.

5. Health Monitoring and Wellbeing:

Health surveillance programs will be in place for employees exposed to significant health risks.

6. Policy Review:

This policy will be reviewed when necessary, including following significant incidents to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.
